Gotong-royong to clean up school

Penang, 14 May 2016 – While their peers were enjoying their weekend break with the family, students of SK Tanjung Tokong gamely sacrificed their Saturday to take part in a *gotong-royong* with their parents at their school here.

Divided into groups, over 100 volunteers led by headmaster Rosli Ahmad literally got their hands dirty at different locations within the school premises with one aim — to rid their school of rubbish.

Armed with brooms, dustpans and garbage bags, they scoured the place — the school hall, the toilets, the field and classrooms --- doggedly ridding these spaces of all forms of rubbish.

Jointly organised by Eastern & Oriental Berhad (E&O) and SK Tanjung Tokong, the event was held to instill a sense of civic mindedness among the children and to encourage them to be responsible for their surroundings.
