# Education aid brings joy to schoolchildren

Penang, 22 November 2017 – Many of us remember the childhood thrill of starting the new school term with brand-new school necessities.

This joy was clearly written on the happy faces of 16 children from the Tanjung Tokong, Gurney Drive and Tanjung Bungah Fishermen Units as they held their new school kits received from Eastern & Oriental Berhad (E&O).

The school necessities assistance presentation ceremony at Dewan Desiran Tanjung Pinang here saw the schoolchildren receiving a school bag, a set of school uniform, a pair of school shoes and socks each.
